Overview

This document is being provided to explain the changes made to the SedonaOffice application since Version 5.7.94. This is an intermediate version update that contains application corrections and enhancements.



Customers updating to 5.7.94 are receiving the latest SedonaOffice application and TLS 1.2. *Customers should read the release notes for 5.7.89/90/91/92 as there were important changes made those versions*.

Application Enhancements/Improvements

Update SedonaOffice TLS 1.0 to TLS 1.2

What is TLS?

Transport Layer Security (TLS) is a technology protocol used to encrypt sensitive information exchanged over the Web.

Why is Forte making this change?

In response to the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards (PCI DSS) version 3.1, Forte will discontinue support for older TLS versions 1.0 and 1.1. **Effective April 3, 2018**, Forte will only

support TLSv1.2, as it is the most secure TLS protocol. More information about the security requirements can be found <u>here</u>.

Timeline:

- On Wednesday, March 7, 2018 from 10:00 am 2:00 pm CST, Forte will be conducting a live production test of the new security protocol.
 - During this 4-hour window, if you have not completed the below requirements you will have a brief disruption of Forte Services (FTP Batch Processing, Live Transactions, Add/Edit CC & ACH).
 - Once the 4-hour window is complete, you will be able to resume use of Forte services until the 4/3/18 deadline.

• On April 3, 2018 Forte will retire support for TLS 1.0 & 1.1 integrations You MUST complete the below requirements to continue using Forte services (FTP Batch Processing, Live Transactions, Add/Edit CC & ACH).

Requirements

- .NET Framework 4.6.1 or greater MUST be installed on all clients (https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=49982) The .Net 4.6.1 requirement may necessitate a system reboot when loaded onto SQL Server, customers and or IT departments should plan accordingly.
- Choose one of the below options: Option 1: Install SedonaOffice version 5.7.0.94 or greater.

Option 2: Run our TLS1.2 Patch tool. This will keep you on your current SedonaOffice version:<u>http://files.sedonaoffice.com/SedonaOffice_Files/Update_Files/TSL12Patch.e</u> xe). You do NOT have to upgrade your SedonaOffice installation to use this patch file BUT you still are required to have .NET 4.6.1

With an exciting 2018 feature packed roadmap, we highly recommend updating SedonaOffice to the latest version. This ensures you will have access to our newest features and products as they become available.
